Please save the date for the Annual Membership Meeting on:


Monday, November 11, 2019 @ 7:00 PM.

Parking Reminders

Please be reminded that parking rules are always in affect and are strictly enforced with daily monitoring. The following circumstances constitute violations of parking requirements within Association neighborhoods:

- a. Unlawfully parking in a "Red Zone" or "Fire Lane."
- b. Unlawfully parking in a "Disabled Parking Space."
- c. Parking with the right wheels of the vehicle more than 18 inches from the right curb.
- d. Parking in any manner that blocks access by another owner or occupant to his or her unit, driveway, or garage.
- e. Parking a commercial vehicle on Association streets.
- f. Parking by guests on the Association streets in excess of seventy-two (72) hours within a seven-day period without a temporary variance.
- g. Parking by residents on Association streets overnight without management acknowledgement/approval.
- h. Parking of a recreational vehicle or trailer of any type on an Association street in excess of forty-eight (48) hours or in any guest parking or no parking area.
- i. Parking by residents in designated guest parking areas.
- j. Overnight parking of any construction vehicle or equipment belonging to residents or contractors, including, but not limited to, trailers, tractors, cement mixers. ■

Holiday Cooking Safeguards

No holiday celebration would be complete without a feast, but be sure to take precautions, unattended cooking is one of the leading causes of home fires. Keep children and flammable items such as grocery bags and kitchen towels away from the stove and oven. Clean up those greasy spills and if you're deep frying a turkey, keep the fryer well away from structures and trees, make sure the turkey is thawed, and always follow the manufacturer instructions.
